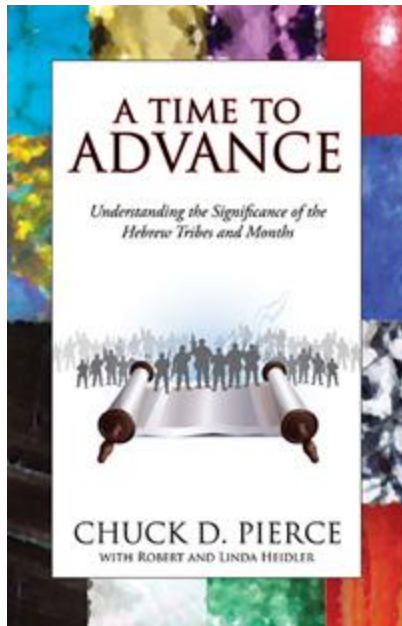
Linda Heidler shared wonderful insight on the Tribe of Asher, and how the fullness of their redemptive identity was tied to and expressed through the land yielding its increase.
